THE WINES OF WAIRARAPA

The Wairarapa features boutique wineries that are relatively small and typically family-owned, with winemakers devoting themselves to producing superior hand-crafted wines.

The Wairarapa's three sub-regions of Martinborough, Gladstone and Masterton are located on ancient alluvial river terraces of deep, free-draining gravel overlaid with gravelly silt loam. They have low rainfall, hot summers and a long dry autumn. This, combined with low yields, provides the right balance of warm days (creating ripeness) and cool nights (creating elegance) for producing top quality Pinot Noir, and other early ripening varieties.

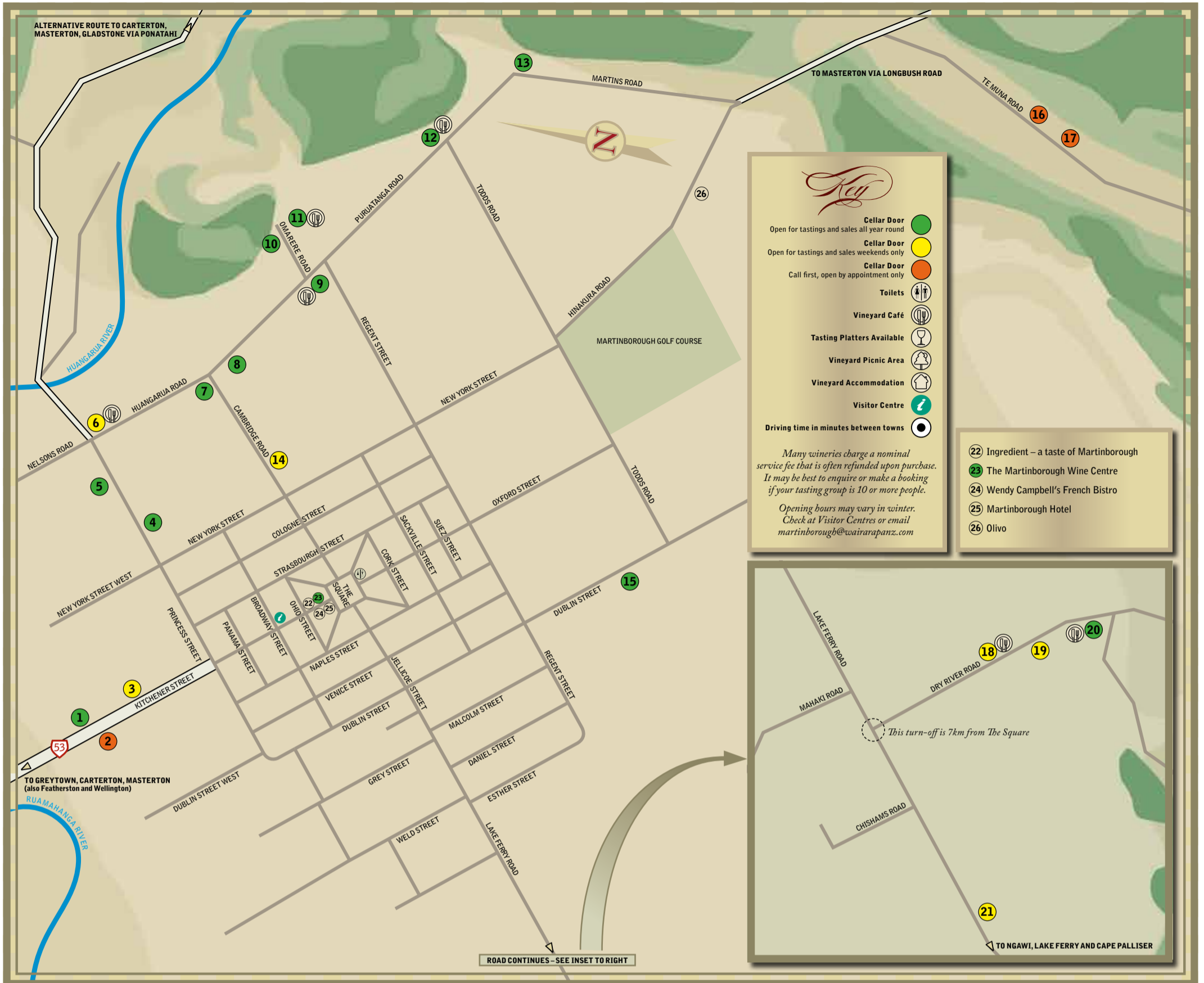
